Alignment of projects with the INTOSAI strategic goals and priorities



Shared responsibilities (2)

Support for the development of individual projects referred to Subcommittees/WGs

Maintenance and development of the ISSAI Framework

Participating, through the PSC-SC, in the governance of FIPP

Maintaining the FIPP membership and selecting FIPP members

Joint Goal Chairs/IDI initiative

Need to ensure all INTOSAI public goods are quality-assured and carry a QA label

Three different QA levels foreseen

Will be discussed at the three steering committees, then sent to the Governing Board

To be overseen by the Goal Chairs and IDI in an administratively light way
