

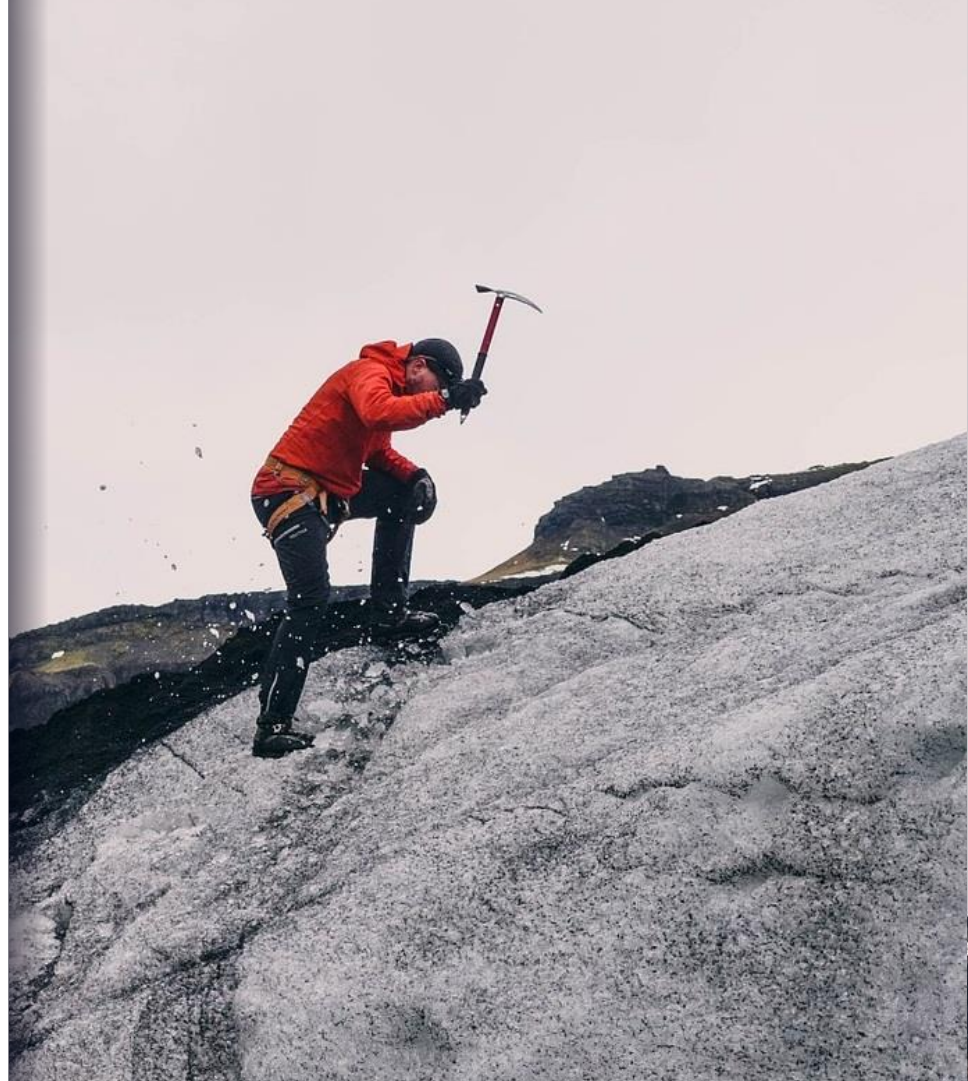

# PSC Mandate 2017-2019



Provide for a strong organizational structure to support standard-setting



Offer strategic guidance and overall coordination of standard-setting



Consolidate the Standards Framework



Support capacity development initiatives for the implementation of INTOSAI Standards



Monitor the implementation and adoption of INTOSAI standards

*“Provide a strong organizational **framework** to support INTOSAI’s standard setting including a permanent standard-setting board (the FIPP), a technical support function, and an independent advisory function”*

## Strategic objective 1 (Developments / implementation)

1. FIPP created and working
2. Discussion of the “technical support function” document
3. Creation of two groups of external stakeholders within the “independent advisory function” to be proposed and discussed in this meeting

*“Ensure that the ISSAIs are sufficiently clear, relevant and appropriate to make them the preferred solution for INTOSAI’s members. The ISSAIs should be widely recognized by all stakeholders as the authoritative framework for public sector auditing”*

## Strategic objective 2 (Developments / implementation)

1. Work together with the Goal Chairs, PSC Subcommittees and FIPP mainly with regard to the implementation/revision of the SDP
2. Continuous work to guarantee the fulfilment of the Due Process
3. Establishment of new partnerships with external stakeholders or strengthen of the existing ones to:
  - ✓ disseminate the knowledge of ISSAIs outside INTOSAI
  - ✓ receive contributions for the standard setting

1. CBC-KSC-PSC collaboration in progress to support activities related to professionalization

4. Project on competency pronouncements in the SDP
