Sl. No.	Working Group	Chair	Name of the Pronouncement	Reasons
1.	Working Group on Environment Audit (WGEA)	Indonesia	ISSAI 5130	This pronouncements is anyway included in the Priority 3 of SDP. SAI Indonesia is yet to get back to us on how they wish to proceed further. We had suggested taking up only one goal, Environment or all the Goals by forming a crosscutting project team consisting of members of all the working groups.
2.	Working Group on Extractive Industries (WGEI)	Uganda	GUID on Audit of Extractive Industries	The Working Group on Extractive Industries was launched in the XXI INCOSAI in 2013. Development of new products have been included for the first time in their work plan 2017-19. Out of the six documents proposed by them, we had suggested Guidance on Extractive Industries to be developed as an IFPP document, being the first GUID on the subject matter.
3.	Working Group on Key National Indicators (WGKNI)	Russia	GUID on Key National Indicators	SAI Russia had recently developed an INTOSAI GOV on the subject which was endorsed in the last INCOSAI. There has been considerable pressure from SAI Russia to develop a GUID on KNI.
4.	Working Group on Public Debt (WGPD)	Mexico	GUID on Public Debt Management Office (PDMO)	There were four documents listed in their work plan. After discussions we were able to convince them to include only one.
5.	Working Group on Value and Benefits to SAIs (WGVBS)	Mexico	GUID for Jurisdictional SAIs Network of General Prosecutors	During the XXII INCOSAI (Dec. 2016), as part of a side event, the

				members of the Forum of Jurisdictional SAIs and other parties (including the INTOSAI General Secretariat and the WGVBS Chair), signed the “Paris Declaration” ¹ . They intend to draft a document, GUID, on jurisdictional control. Due to considerable interest shown by Jurisdictional SAIs, it may be appropriate to include the same in the SDP.
6.	Working Group on Public Procurement Audit (WGPPA)	Russia	GUID on Public Procurement Audit	Working Group on Public Procurement Audit (WGPPA) was recently accorded the status of Working Group in 2016. Earlier, it was in the form of Task Force. One of the reasons for creation of this WG was to enable them to develop a GUID on the subject matter, on which they had already done considerable amount of work.
